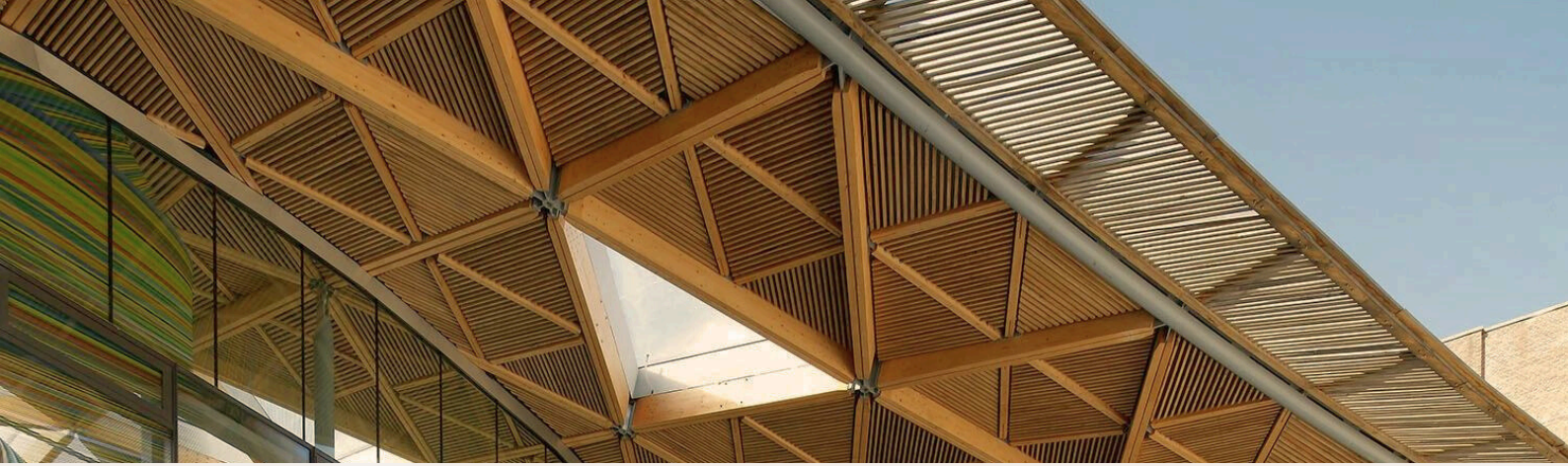

# VISA APPLICATION

01

## CAS

You will receive your CAS statement, Certificate of Acceptance of Studies, from the University of Exeter via email.

02

## Apply online

<https://www.gov.uk/student-visa>  
Fill in the necessary information.

03

## Pay

Pay the application fee of £524 and the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS) of £776 per year of study. The application website will bring you to the payment page.

04

## Book an appointment

You will have to submit documents and provide your biometric information.

The application website will bring you to the page where you can book an appointment at the Visa Application Centre.

05

## Visit the Visa application centre

Bring the required documents to the centre:

- Appointment confirmation letter
- Valid passport
- Your document checklist (provided as you finish the application online)
- You can upload your supporting documents online through VFS.global.
- Check if you need the following before you apply.
- ATAS certificate (if required by your course)
- tuberculosis test results (<https://www.gov.uk/tb-test-visa>)

## East Park

## MyExeter

MyExeter is the app for University of Exeter students. Through this app, you can do a variety of different things such as keeping on top of your timetable, check-in to classes, and much more.



## Apple Taxi

Uber is not commonly used in Exeter. Instead, taxis are better called via their app or via their phone number.



## Trainline

Trainline is one of the most popular apps used for buying train tickets. For those living in university accommodation, Exeter St David's is most likely to be your closest station, where you can find a taxi station right outside.



## Railcard

A rail card is highly recommended for those who plan to travel a lot during their time in the UK. With a Railcard, you can save a third on all your rail fares. You can purchase a 1-year 16-25 Railcard for just £35 or a 3-year Railcard for £80.



## National Express

National Express is the UK coach service that provides services straight from Heathrow Terminals to Exeter City Centre for an average of 4 hours. They can be very cheap if bought in advance.
